



# Do You Remember?



## That...



The Approving Officer should give a **'Tentative Go'** approval to projects or programmes that have been developed for resource mobilization purposes. That is, where the intention of the Project Manager/Initiator is to use the **Project Document to mobilize resources** / seek donor or recipient country's interest and funding.



In the above case, when the Project or Programme becomes a reality, that is, it has been fully **translated into concrete**/hard pipeline; the Project Manager/Initiator **should return** the Project Document initially approved as 'Tentative Go' to the original Approving Officer **after** ensuring that all necessary **changes have been made** to the Project Document to **reflect** the **latest/actual reality** (changes to: scope, budget, risk, assumptions, and the logframe).

## And by the way ...



The Approving Officer will need to make a **judgement call** on whether to give a **'Full Go'** approval **or** to refer the Project or Programme **back** to the PAG Technical review team for a re-review.



If a 'Full Go' approval is given, the Project Manager/Initiator is expected to **update PAAS** accordingly. This is critical.
